Day Care Centre

The Day Care Centre (DCC) caters to day scholars aged 6 months to 3 years from the urban-slum, with a current enrolment of around 100 children.

The DCC adopts proven play-based learning and Montessori methods as part of its pedagogy to promote the child's holistic development, encouraging language and pre-literacy skills, social and emotional skills, and fostering creativity and imagination.

It serves as a model centre of excellence in Early Childhood Care and Development for other NGOs and professionals in the field.

Vidyalaya – Kindergarten and Primary School

The Vidyalaya is a full-fledged English-medium Kindergarten and Primary School catering to children from the Bala Mandir institution and the urban-slums aged 4 –10 years (Lower Kindergarten - Standard V). This school was begun to fulfil the aspirations of the parents who wanted their children to have a better future.

It offers excellent infrastructure, well-qualified and trained teachers, a bi-lingual curriculum teaching English and Tamil, and integration with Elementary Montessori. It also offers various co-curricular activities, such as art and craft, physical education/yoga, music, and dance as well as computer classes, learning support and inclusion of children with special needs.

Satyamurthi High School

The Satyamurthi High School (SMHS) currently caters to children from the Bala Mandir institution and the urban-slums aged 11-15 years (Standard VI–X). It consists of a Government-aided Tamil-medium section and a self-financing English-medium section.

It offers many co-curricular activities and facilities to enhance the quality of education and learning, such as value education, health education, art and craft and life-skills programmes, as well as science and computer laboratories, a library and a special education wing covering learning support, occupational therapy and behaviour counselling.
